

## Admission for UG (BE) and PG (MBA & MCA) Courses

### About the Institute:

Vidya Vikas Institute of Engineering and Technology (VVIET) is approved by All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi and Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Karnataka State. It is affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi, Karnataka.

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The Institute adhere to the rules and regulation laid down by DTE and KEA, Government of Karnataka for the entire process to the First Year B.E (Regular), the second-year B.E lateral entry and the PG (MBA & MCA) courses. The Institute Admission section looks after the entire admission process.

### Admission Section:

Principal is the Chairman of the Admission Section. The admission section consists of the Registrar, Assistant administrative officer, and case worker(s) to oversee the admission matters. Admission of students to first semester/Third semester Lateral Entry (diploma) and onwards shall be made and updated regularly. The following registers/ files should be maintained in the form of hard copy, and they shall discharge duties as specified below.

- Admission registers of students.
- Demand, collection, and balance (DCB) register.
- Files containing all the original academic documents of the students admitted to the first semester /Third semester (diploma). They shall be returned to the concerned students at the time of course completion and leaving the college, with approval of the principal.
- Files of transfer certificates, migration certificates, eligibility certificates and equivalent certificates.
- Issue of bonified /study certificates.
- Information about scholarship schemes.
- Maintenance of files related to all correspondence.
- Documents containing rules, regulations, orders, notification, circulars, etc. relating to admissions and to update regularly.

## Admission Process:

### Eligibility for Admission to B.E Regular Programme through CET:

- Candidate should have passed in 2nd PUC / 12th Std / Equivalent Exam with English as one of the Languages and obtained a Minimum of 45% of Marks in aggregate in Physics and Mathematics along with Chemistry / Biotechnology / Biology / Electronics / Computer. (40% for SC, ST, Cat-1, 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B category candidates). As notified in KEA brochure.
- Candidates should have a qualifying rank in either CET or COMED-K entrance test. CET will be conducted for the students of Karnataka by The Karnataka Examination Authority. COMEDK will be conducted for Karnataka and non-Karnataka students.
- All the above may be subjected to revision from time to time by Government order. Refer to the circular by the Government of Karnataka and KEA every year. (<https://cetonline.karnataka.gov.in/kea/indexnew>)



### Eligibility for Admission to B.E Programme through Management Quota:

- Management quota seats are available for B.E, courses for students who meet eligibility criteria mentioned above. 25% of the sanctioned intake is reserved for Management Quota. Candidates need to visit the college to fill in the application form. Based on merit, the candidates who have filled in the application form will be called for counselling by the admission committee.
- Every seat allotment and admission will be purely based on merit.
- Candidates should have a qualifying rank in either CET/COMED-K/Any other national entrance test conducted during the admission year pertaining to engineering.

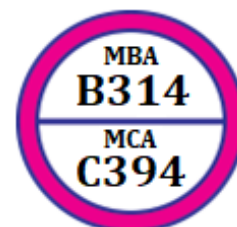
### Eligibility for Admission to B.E (Second year) Programme through Lateral Entry:

- 10% of sanctioned intake, which will be over and above, Supernumerary to the approved Intake.
- Vacant Seats: The seats, within the sanctioned intake, which remain vacant during previous year are allotted to lateral entry admission to second year.
- The admission is completely through KEA.
- All the above may be subjected to revision from time to time by Government order. Refer to the circular by the Government and KEA every year. (<https://cetonline.karnataka.gov.in/kea/indexnew>)



## Eligibility for Admission to Regular MBA and MCA Programme:

- d. The eligibility condition of 50% maximum CGPA or 50% of the marks secured at graduate level for seeking admission to VTU – PG programmes from the AY: 2022-23 and onwards. The class/marks for admission approval shall be considered as per the policy of degree awarding University.
- e. 50% in all years for general merit, 45% in all years for SC, ST and Category-I (Karnataka Candidates).
- f. For admission under Government quota: ranks obtained in PG CET entrance exam, conducted by Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA), shall be considered.
- g. 50% of the sanctioned intake is reserved for Government quota.



## Eligibility for Admission to MBA and MCA Programme through Management Quota:

- a. 50% of the sanctioned intake is reserved for Management quota.
- b. Entrance Examination conducted by KEA (PGCET)/Karnataka Management Aptitude Test (KMAT) or appeared and qualified under any approved entrance examination conducted by the authority recognized by Government of Karnataka/VTU /any other University of Karnataka state. (KMAT/ CAT/ MAT/ XAT).
- c. The eligibility condition of 50% maximum CGPA or 50% of the marks secured at graduate level for seeking admission to VTU – PG programmes from the AY: 2022-23 and onwards. The class/marks for admission approval shall be considered as per the policy of degree awarding University.
- d. All the above may be subjected to revision from time to time by Government order. Refer to the circular by the Government and KEA (<https://cetonline.karnataka.gov.in/kea/indexnew>) every year.
